# Getting There



#### **Train**

Trains run from Victoria to Plumpton every 60mins and take an hour. Plumpton station is a 20 minute walk from the Artelium.



#### By Car

There is parking at Plumpton Station (BN7 3BW) and it is free on weekends.

A stunning circular hike up onto the South Downs, before finishing at one of England's most beautiful wine estates.

#### START AT PLUMPTON STATION

We begin our walk at the grade II listed Plumpton station which first opened in 1847.



#### **PLUMPTON RACECOURSE**

With 130 years of racing history, the course is a hidden gem for racing enthusiasts and casual spectators alike.

#### **HEART SHAPED SPINNEY**



From the path leading towards the ridge you might be able to spot a heart shaped spinney.

### **VIEW FROM SOUTH DOWNS RIDGE**

To the South you will see Brighton and the Rampion wind farm with 116 turbines that produces power for 350,000 homes a year.

#### **SOUTH DOWNS WAY**

160km long National Trail that follows ancient routes and droveways along the chalk escarpment.



#### THE PINK PIT STOP

This adored pink oasis on the top of the ridge has locally roasted coffee and sweet & savoury snacks.

### **CHALK GRASSLAND**

Chalk downland is an internationally rare habitat that supports as many as 45 species per square meter.


### WESTMESTON CHURCH YARD

This church has a beautiful red brick path running through a live church yard full of wild flowers.

### FINISH AT ARTELIUM (Open Thursday - Sunday)

Finish off your walk with a tour of the vineyards and a wine tasting along side Artelium's fantastic art collection.

#### Grapes on the vine!


To see grapes on the vine at Artelium, visit in July.
