## Getting There



### Train, bus or taxi

The walk starts and ends at Arundel station. Trains to Arundel Station run from London Victoria on Southern Railway and take 1hr 30mins.



### By Car

Parking in Arundel can be tricky with so many visitors to the castle but there are 3 options available. There is a large car park at Arundel Station ([BN18 9JL](#)) which is further out and might help you avoid traffic on busy days. Mill Road Car Park is close to the center and perfect for mid week visits ([BN18 9PA](#)). Then there is the Lido car park that is inbetween ([BN18 9JG](#)).

### ARUNDEL STATION

Built under a 150 year condition from the Duke of Norfolk that all trains stop in Arundel. This expired in 2013.



### A BITE TO EAT BEFORE

Take a small detour into Arundel to visit Partners Cafe for it’s honest and tasty food. For something more upscale Green & Coal is our pick.



The river is 37 miles long and is the longest river that runs entirely through Sussex .



## MONARCH'S WAY

This 625 mile long footpath was used by Charles II in 1651 to flee after defeat at the Battle of Worcester.



## HIORNE TOWER

Built in 1797 by Francis Hiorne as he bid for the contract to rebuild the castle.



## ARUNDEL CATHEDRAL

The Fifteenth Duke of Norfolk, built the Cathedral in 1868.



## ARUNDEL CASTLE

The first stone of the castle was laid down by Roger de Montgomery on Christmas Day 1067. Now the home of the Duke of Norfolk and open to public.



## FAUNA BREWERY

Make sure you stop by Fauna Brewery at the end of your walk to claim your **free** half pint! We strongly recommend the fantastic pizza to go with it!



## FINISH IN ARUNDEL

Before heading to the station, consider checking out the fantastic local shops Arundel has to offer.

# TAKING IT ALL IN

Sometimes, we can get so caught up in reaching our destination that we forget to take in our surroundings. When in fact, some of the best moments on a walk are the ones spent not walking. It is not until you stop and look a little closer, that you truly see the magic of where you are.

Our hikes are not about how fast you walk, but about how much you take in. We share these beautiful trails with an abundance of wildlife and there's always something to marvel at – so long as you take the time to look around.

Here are a few of our favourite bits of flora and fauna to look out for on this hike:



## **Peregrine falcon**

Look out for this distinctive bird of prey.

## **Heron**

A common and majestic sight along the river Arun.



## **Kingfisher**

Often seen only as a rapid flash of blue around waterways.

## CALLING IT A DAY?

If you've decided that's quite enough for you, there's absolutely no shame in calling it a day.

Our recommended pick-up spot is from South Stoke or Burpham. A taxi back to the station takes around 10 or 5 minutes respectively and will cut your hike short by either 7km or 10km.
